


| <p><b>Session Information:</b></p> <p style="color: red;"><b>February 2, 2017 – March 24, 2017</b><br/>(Must complete within 2 months of starting)</p>   | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Each student must complete four sessions (of 30 questions each) that should last approximately 45-55 minutes.</li> <li>Students will need headphones to listen to instructions and complete the session.</li> <li>The four sessions can be spaced throughout the testing window or completed on consecutive days.</li> </ul> |
| <p><b>Logging in:</b></p> <p>On the internet browser of your choice, navigate to <a href="http://isip.istation.com">isip.istation.com</a>.</p> <p>Make sure the domain is set correctly for your school: (school.district.state).</p> <p>Students will log in with the same username and password they use for Istation Reading.</p> <p>Click on the <b>Algebra 1 IRT</b> button (for 8th and 9th grade students enrolled in Algebra 1).</p> |    |
