

## **Educator Implementation Checklist**

## **BEFORE FIRST ASSESSMENT:**

	Istation app is downloaded (by district technical team) and ready for student use.  Student and educator data is imported into Istation to create user accounts (by district data coordinator).  Educators have received e-mails from accounts@istation.com containing domain, login, and password link.  Reliable headsets are connected to student technology where Istation will be used.  Student login cards are printed and ready for student use. (Log in to www.istation.com to find the Help Center and visit the "Help Center Day 1" page for more info.)  Plan to actively monitor students during assessment to ensure fidelity of program results.  Recommended: Teachers may log in to Istation student app to experience/model ISIP™ assessments.*
ASSESSMENT TIME:	
	Students complete their first assessment.  The first time a student logs in each month, an ISIP assessmentwill begin automatically after <b>Reading with</b> ISIP or Lectura con ISIP is selected. Assessments may take 30-40 minutes, depending on the student and the number of subtests given at that particular time of year for a particular student.  Students take ISIP assessment_monthly to ensure consistent data.
AFTER EACH ASSESSMENT, TEACHERS MAY VIEW THE FOLLOWING REPORTS:  (You may visit the Help Center to view videos and handouts on each of the reports.)	
	ISIP Summary Report: This report shows student performance and tier levels.  Priority Report: This report shows priority intervention needs by student and links to written teacher-directed lessons.  Skill Growth Report (beginning after second assessment): This report shows student progress.
AFTER EACH ASSESSMENT, ADMINISTRATORS MAY VIEW THE FOLLOWING REPORTS: (You may visit the Help Center to view videos and handouts on each of the reports.)	
	Assessment Completion Report: This report shows which classes and students have completed the assessment for the reporting period.  Executive Summary Report (only available to manager accounts): This report provides a brief overview of the current ISIP assessment and provides information only for the school or district level.  Priority Summary Report (only available to manager accounts): This report summarizes the use of the Priority Report by averaging how many days it has taken to acknowledge student alerts on the Priority Report.

<sup>\*</sup> Educators can also log in to the program to take an assessment or model doing so for a student. Educators must use their own account information in order to prevent creating any additional data that would skew campus/district data.
